The Letter of Commitment is one of the unique elements of the Huys Scholarship application. It is our challenge to you, to clearly define how you will be utilizing the knowledge, experience, and networks that you will be obtaining with the help of the Huys Scholarship to address a concrete problem facing Armenia, the Armenian nation, or humanity.

Your Letter of Commitment should be actionable and concrete, not abstract and vague.

Here are some prompts that may help you to do this.

- **Problem:** Please identify and substantiate an immediate need, skills shortage, and/or target area for Armenia, the Armenian nation, or humanity.
- **Your Credentials:** Please identify and substantiate the learning, experience, and networks that you will obtain through completing the academic degree program.
- **Solution:** Please identify and substantiate how such learning, experience, and networks may be directed toward successfully addressing the challenge you've identified for Armenia, the Armenian nation, or humanity.
